

CALL FOR TOOL DEMONSTRATIONS

As well-established tradition, the Conference on Software Engineering Education and Training (CSEE&T) is an academic conference providing a platform for software engineering educators as well as industrial trainers to communicate on a variety of topics and actual issues related to software engineering education, training, and professionalism. The special theme of CSEE&T 2020 will be "*Educating for the Future*".

CSEE&T 2020 particularly invites proposals for **tool demonstrations**. Calls for all kinds of contributions (among others, long and short research papers, industrial experience reports, panel sessions, poster presentations, tutorials and practice & methods presentations) can be found at <u>http://conferences.computer.org/cseet/2020</u>.

Tool Demonstration Submission Information

We invite high-quality submissions of extended abstracts for the demonstration of tools related to the conference topics of software engineering education and training. Tool demonstrations provide the opportunity to show any innovative tools or research prototypes. We encourage submissions on tools that are:

- Research tools from academic environments built to support novel research ideas
- Extensions of existing or open source tools
- Pedagogical tools that support teaching of software engineering
- Mature tools not yet commercialized

The tool demonstration submission needs to be accompanied by an extended abstract which contains the following contents:

- Title
- Author(s) and affiliation(s)
- Motivation and goals
- Relevance of the tool for software engineering education
- Novelty and innovations of the tool and its main features
- Maturity of the tool: case studies performed using the tool
- Links to additional information (e.g., project Website, source code repository, demo material, etc.)

The extended abstract has to adhere to the IEEE formatting instructions and is restricted to two pages. For each tool demonstration, as least one author has to register for the conference by May 9, 2020. After registration, each accepted poster abstract will be published in the conference proceedings.
